No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-01070; Ken Loo

Dear Ken Loo:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to an AdWatch submission that alleged you violated the text message advertisement disclaimer provisions of the Act. After our review of the case, the Enforcement Division has found the allegation to be disproven, based on the fact that you did not qualify as a committee under the Act. Accordingly, you did not violate Government Code Sections 84502 and 84504.7. Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
