No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC Case No. 2024-01022; Quoc Tran

Dear Rebekah Davis-Matthews:

This letter is in response to the referral your office submitted to the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission regarding the above-named individual's failure to timely file their Assuming Office and Leaving Office Statements of Economic Interests ("SEIs"). Your office indicated that they do not have current contact information for Quoc Tran. The Enforcement Division has made attempts to locate current contact information, however, our attempts have been unsuccessful. For these reasons, we are closing this case without further action.

If your office is able to obtain current contact information, you may re-refer Quoc Tran to the Enforcement Division if the missing SEIs are not filed in response to at least two written notifications from your office.
