The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a complaint that alleged you failed to report gifts from the Girardi Keese Law Firm on your Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) as the State Bar Executive Director. After conducting our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division determined there is insufficient evidence to support a finding that you violated the Act, and we are closing this matter without further action.
