No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00584; Mary Badame

Dear Mary Badame:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you failed to properly disclose certain economic interests on several of your Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) for your position as a Councilmember for the City Council of Los Gatos. It also appears that you failed to timely file Assuming Office SEIs for your position as a City Council Member and a member of the Boards for the West Valley Sanitation District, the West Valley Clean Water Program Authority, and the West Valley Solid Waste Management Authority. Additionally, you failed to timely file a Leaving Office SEI for your position with the West Valley Sanitation District.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have filed the missing SEIs and have filed amendments to your SEIs to properly disclose your reportable economic interests. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement, i.e., failure to timely file Assuming Office SEIs and a Leaving Office SEI, pursuant to Section 91013.
