The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a Commission-initiated complaint alleging violations of the Act's advertisement disclosure provisions. After our investigation and review of the case, the Enforcement Division has found insufficient evidence that you qualified as a committee requiring advertisement disclosures.
