No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00766; Raj Salwan

Dear Raj Salwan:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you failed to properly disclose certain economic interests on your 2021 and 2022 Annual Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) for your position as an Alternate Member for the Alameda County Transportation Commission.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have filed amendments to your SEIs to properly disclose your reportable economic interests. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
