**No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00921; Sean Conley-Widing**

Dear Sean Conley-Widing:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).<sup>1</sup> This letter is in response to referrals from the County of El Dorado alleging that you failed to timely file your Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as an Assessor for the Information Tech Department with the County of El Dorado and your 2023 Annual SEI for your position as a Director for the Rising Hill Road Community Services District.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have filed the missing SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement, i.e., failure to timely file your Leaving Office and 2023 Annual SEIs, assessed by your filing officer, the County of El Dorado, pursuant to Section 91013.
