No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00817; Carlos Villapudua for Assembly – 2022, Carlos Villapudua for State Senate 2024, and Carlos Villapudua

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an AdWatch submission indicating that you failed to include the proper advertisement disclosures on certain advertisements disseminated by the committee Carlos Villapudua for Assembly – 2022.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding advertisements. For this reason, we are closing this matter without further action.
