No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2025-00501; Robert Torres

Dear Robert Torres:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) received a referral from the Commission’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your 2023 Annual and Leaving Office SEIs as a City Council Member for the City of Pomona.

Because it did not appear that you received any notifications from the Commission’s SEI Unit pertaining to your Leaving Office SEI, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file the 2023 Annual and Leaving Office SEIs. Immediately after you received the notification, you responded and filed your 2023 Annual and Leaving Office SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the Commission’s SEI Unit.
