Dear Dave Cooper:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint that alleged you failed to timely disclose economic interests on your Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as a Board Member for the City of Santa Rosa Board of Building Appeals.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you had already filed your 2022 Annual SEI prior to completion of PREP. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
