Dear Jeffrey De La Torre:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (the “Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act,” contained in Government Code sections 81000 through 91014). This letter is in response to a sworn complaint, which included allegations that you failed to timely disclose real property on multiple Form 700 Statements of Economic Interest (SEI filings)—in connection with your position as a Board Member with Hacienda La Puente Unified School District.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEI filings—and you have filed required corrective amendments. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
