No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00188; Gino Kwok

Dear Gary Winuk:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging your client, Gino Kwok, failed to timely disclose certain economic interests on Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) as a Governing Board Member with the Hacienda La Puente Unified School District. Additionally, the complaint alleged Gino Kwok violated the Act’s conflict of interest provisions. Our investigation determined there was insufficient evidence to support a finding that your client violated the Act’s conflict of interest provisions.

The Enforcement Division found that Gino Kwok successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, amendments to SEIs to disclose reportable economic interests were filed. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
