Dear Fatima Malik and Malik for SMUD Board 2020:

The Enforcement Division of the California Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to our case concerning an anonymous complaint alleging you and Malik for SMUD Board 2020 (“Committee”) failed to timely report in-kind contributions on 24-Hour Contribution Reports in connection with the November 3, 2020 General Election.

The Enforcement Division found insufficient evidence to support that there was a violation of the Act. As such, the Enforcement Division has decided to close this matter without further action.
