No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00679; Committee to Elect Stacey Bastian for Twin Rivers Unified School District Board of Trustees Area 4 2022, Stacey Bastian, and Susan Bastian

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from Sacramento County Voter Registration & Elections alleging that you failed to timely file your Form 410 Amendment upon qualifying as a committee, and failed to timely file your 2023 and 2024 Semi-Annual campaign statements covering the periods of January 1, 2023 to June 30, 2023; July 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023; January 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024; and July 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024 by their specified deadlines.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed the missing campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file semi-annual campaign statements), assessed by your filing officer, Sacramento County Voter Registration and Elections, pursuant to Section 91013.
