The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This letter is in response to your sworn complaints alleging James Larry Minor ("Minor"), as a member of the Board of Directors for the Lake Hemet Municipal Water District, failed to timely disclose certain interests on Annual Statements of Economic Interests and participated in decisions in which Minor had a conflict of interest.

After conducting our investigation and review of the case, we are closing this matter without further action because Minor is now deceased.
