No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2025-00691; Gina Clayton-Tarvin, Committee to Re-Elect Gina Clayton-Tarvin for Ocean View School District 2028, Mark Bixby

Dear Gina Clayton-Tarvin, Mark Bixby, and Committee:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you failed to timely file 24-Hour Contribution Reports for non-monetary contributions made covering the period of May 25, 2025.

The Enforcement Division found that the committee’s treasurer successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed the missing 24-Hour Contribution Reports for non-monetary contributions made. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file 24-Hour Contribution Reports for non-monetary contributions made), assessed by your filing officer, the Orange County Registrar of Voters, pursuant to Section 91013.
