Dear San Bernardino County Patriots

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that the San Bernardino County Patriots distributed campaign-related text messages in support of Luis Centina's candidacy for San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors prior to the July 7, 2022 Primary Election without the proper advertisement disclosure. The Enforcement Division completed its investigation and has decided to close its file on this matter without further action.

The allegations have been disproven because San Bernardino County Patriots did not raise or spend enough money to qualify as a committee under the Act, and therefore, the text messages did not require an advertisement disclosure. For this reason, we are closing this matter.
