The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This case arises from an anonymous complaint, which included allegations regarding campaign money laundering with respect to contributions made by your family (and business associates) to the committee known as Ted Gaines for Governor 2021.

I am writing to inform you of the results of our investigation. We found insufficient evidence to support a finding that the Act was violated, and this case is being closed without further action.
