No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2025-00317; Heidi Hall for Roseville Joint Union High School District 2020, Heidi Hall

Dear Heidi Hall and Committee:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the County of Placer alleging that you failed to timely file semi-annual campaign statements for the reporting periods of January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022, by the July 31, 2022 deadline; July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022, by the January 31, 2023 deadline; January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023, by the July 31, 2023 deadline; July 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, by the January 31, 2024 deadline; and January 1, 2024 through June 30, 2024, by the July 31, 2025 deadline.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed the missing campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file the above-referenced semi-annual campaign statements), assessed by your filing officer, the County of Placer, pursuant to Section 91013.
