No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2024-00577; Independent Voter Project

Dear Dan Howle:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a request by the Audits and Assistance Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission to issue subpoenas for records related to discretionary audits to verify compliance with reporting requirements under Government Code Section 89506, subdivision (f), and Regulation 18940. In order to facilitate the issuing of subpoenas for the Audits and Assistance Division, a case number was assigned. At the February 13, 2025, Commission Meeting, the Audits and Assistance Division presented their findings and found that the Independent Voter Project did not meet the 1/3 filing threshold required to mandate the filing of a Form 807 (Nonprofit Travel Payments, Advances and Reimbursements Donor Disclosure List). Therefore, we are closing this matter without further action.
