**No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00405; Mary Wells**

Dear Mary Wells:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).<sup>1</sup> This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that you failed to timely file your 2019 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) and failed to timely disclose certain economic interests on your SEIs for your positions as a Member of the Citizens’ Bond Oversight Committee and Board Member for the Beverly Hills Unified School District.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you amended the applicable SEIs to disclose sources of income. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
