The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the FPPC’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your Candidate SEI for your position as a Candidate for City Council Member for the City of Richmond in the November 8, 2022 General Election.
