No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00879; Brando Villapudua

Dear Brando Villapudua:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you failed to timely disclose a source of income on Annual Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) for your positions as a Planning Commissioner and City Councilmember for the City of Stockton.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (“PREP”) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you subsequently amended the applicable annual SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
