No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC Case No. 2021-00823; Paul Courtney

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This case arises from two anonymous complaints. Based on these complaints, we conducted an investigation regarding potential violations of the Act with respect to mass mailings sent at public expense.
