No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2025-00191; Tiffany Boyd-Hodgson

Dear Tiffany Boyd-Hodgson,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that you failed to disclose certain economic interests on your Statement of Economic Interests (SEI) as a candidate for the Vallecitos Water District Board.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you filed an amendment to your Candidate SEI to disclose your reportable economic interests. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
