No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2025-000853; Charity Jackson

Dear Charity Jackson,

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (the “Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ The investigation against Washington County Water District (FPPC Case No. 2020-01083) was completed and as a result of the findings of that case, the Enforcement Division opened this case and determined that you failed to timely file your 2021 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”).

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have filed all of the required SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement, i.e., failure to timely file 2021 Annual SEI, assessed by your filing officer, Nevada County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Section 91013.
