No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2025-01122; Tom Schwedhelm

Dear Tom Schwedhelm,

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from Sonoma County regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) as a Board Member with the Santa Rosa Plain Groundwater Sustainability Agency.

Because the notifications regarding your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency’s e-mail address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the County of Sonoma.
