No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2023-00340; Jerry Danielsen 4 COC Board 2020, Jerry Danielsen, and Richard Evans

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you failed to include street addresses for your committee and contributors on campaign statements, incorrectly used acronyms instead of full names when reporting contributor information, and failed to timely report campaign activity on your pre-election and semi-annual campaign statements in connection with the November 3, 2020 General Election.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed amendments to your campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely report the committee and contributor street addresses on campaign statements, failure to use full names instead of acronyms when reporting contributor information, failure to timely file a 24-hour contribution report, failure to timely report two expenditures on the semi-annual campaign statement covering October 18, 2020 to December 31, 2020), assessed by your filing officer, the Los Angeles County Clerk Recorder, pursuant to Section 91013.
