No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC Case No. 2024-00284; Michelle Bushnell

Dear Supervisor Bushnell:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act.¹ This case arises from a sworn complaint and two anonymous complaints, which raised concerns about an alleged conflict of interest by you with respect to actions taken relative to Measure A (a cannabis cultivation measure on the ballot in March 2024).

However, our investigation found insufficient evidence to support a finding that you violated the Act. One complaint also raised concerns about potential failure to report a source of income on one or more Form 700 statement of economic interest filings, but this was disproven.
