No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2025-00142; Daniel Nathan-Heiss, Daniel Nathan-Heiss For Contra Costa County Board of Education 2024

Dear Gary Winuk:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint indicating that your clients, Daniel Nathan-Heiss and Daniel Nathan-Heiss for Contra Costa County Board of Education 2024 failed to timely file a 24-Hour Report and failed to timely report campaign activity on a pre-election campaign statement for the reporting period of September 22, 2024 through October 19, 2024.

The Enforcement Division found that your clients successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, the pre-election campaign statement was amended to report the previously undisclosed non-monetary contribution. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely report contributions on your pre-election campaign statement, and failure to file a 24-Hour Report), assessed by your filing officer, Contra Costa County Clerk-Recorder, pursuant to Section 91013.
