Dear Lara Bergthold:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the City of Berkeley regarding your failure to timely file Assuming Office and Leaving Office Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) for your position as a Consultant with the Health, Housing, and Community Services Department.

Because it did not appear you were properly notified by the City regarding the requirement to file the SEIs, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the missing SEIs. After you received the notification, you filed your missing SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, City of Berkeley.
