Dear Mark Landman:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received referrals from the County of Sonoma regarding your failure to timely file your 2022 Annual and Leaving Office Statements of Economic Interests (“SEIs”) for your positions as a Board Member with the Regional Climate Protection Authority, a Board Member with the Santa Rosa Plain Groundwater Sustainability Agency, and a Board Member with the Transportation Authority. Additionally, we received a referral from the County of Sonoma regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office SEI for your position as a Commissioner with the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO).

Because it appeared that the County’s notifications regarding the missing SEIs were sent to your City of Cotati email address after you left your position with the City, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file your missing SEIs. Immediately after you received the notification, you responded and filed the missing SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the County of Sonoma.
