Dear Venmer Deocariza:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the Santa Clara County Clerk of the Board of Supervisors regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for your position as an Administration Chief with the South Santa Clara County Fire District.

Because the County’s notifications pertaining to your requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency email address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. After you received the notification, you filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, Santa Clara County.
