No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2023-00307; Antelope Valley Taxpayer Advocates, Josh Mann, and Mark Bozigian

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a non-sworn complaint alleging that your committee failed to timely file the first pre-election campaign statement covering July 1, 2022 to September 24, 2022 due by September 29, 2022, and failed to timely file three 24-Hour Reports in connection with the November 8, 2022 General Election.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for General Purpose and Primarily Formed Committees. In addition, you have filed the missing campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file a pre-election campaign statement and 24-Hour Reports), assessed by your filing officer, the Secretary of State, pursuant to Section 91013.
