No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2025-00015; Friends of Julie Leavens Hupp for Rocklin School Board 2020, Friends of Julie Hupp for Rocklin School Board 2024, and Julie Leavens Hupp

Dear Julie Leavens Hupp and Committees:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to two sworn complaints alleging violations of the Act. Our investigation found that you failed to timely file six semi-annual campaign statements for the reporting periods ending on June 30, 2022; December 31, 2022; June 30, 2023; December 31, 2023; June 30, 2024; and December 31, 2024. Our investigation also found that you failed to timely file four 24-hour reports for four contributions received on August 15, 2024; August 27, 2024; September 25, 2024; and October 15, 2024. Further, our investigation found that you failed to timely file statements of organization to report the committees’ qualification dates and failed to timely report all required information for contributions and expenditures received during the reporting periods ending on December 31, 2024; September 21, 2024; October 19, 2024; and June 30, 2025.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, in response to the complaints, you filed the past-due campaign statement(s). For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file semi-annual campaign statements for the reporting periods ending on June 30, 2022; December 31, 2022; June 30, 2023; December 31, 2023; June 30, 2024; and December 31, 2024), assessed by your filing officer, the Placer County Elections Office, pursuant to Section 91013.

¹ The Political Reform Act is contained in Government Code sections 81000 through 91014, and all statutory references are to this code. The regulations of the Fair Political Practices Commission are contained in Sections 18104 through 18998 of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, and all regulatory references are to this source.
