No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00542; Daryoush Davidi, Aliza Davidi, and Davidi for San Rafael City Council 2026

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an AdWatch submission indicating that you and your candidate-controlled committee, Davidi for San Rafael City Council 2026 (the “Committee”), failed to include the proper advertisement disclosures on the cover or header photo of the Committee’s Facebook page, and in response to a commission-initiated investigation indicating that you failed to timely file an amendment to the statement or organization for the Committee.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Advertisements and the Commission’s PREP course regarding Campaign Reporting for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have added the advertisement disclosure to the Committee’s Facebook page and filed an amendment to the statement of organization disclosing the Committee’s qualification date. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
