No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00655; Tonia Watkins

Dear Tonia Watkins:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (the “Commission”) received a referral from the Commission’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office SEI as a Member of the Board of Directors for Northern Orange County Liability and Property Self-Insurance.

Because the notifications regarding your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency’s email address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the Commission’s SEI Unit.
