No Action Closure Letter re FPPC Case No. 2022-00378; In the Matter of Jesus Eduardo Escobar

Dear Jesus Eduardo Escobar:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to several filing officer referrals alleging that you failed to timely file the 2021 and 2022 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) for Golden State Finance Authority (“Golden State Finance”), Assuming and Leaving Office SEI for Rural Counties’ Environmental Services Joint Powers Authority (“Rural Counties’ JPA”), and at least one SEI for the San Diego Association of Governments (“SANDAG”) by their due date.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course on Statement of Economic Interests. For this reason, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failing to timely file the 2022 Annual SEI for Golden State Finance by the April 3, 2023 due date; Assuming Office SEI for Rural Counties’ JPA by the February 1, 2021 due date; Leaving Office SEI for Rural Counties’ JPA by the January 31, 2022 due date; 2020 Annual SEI for SANDAG by the April 1, 2021 due date; and 2022 Annual SEI for SANDAG by the April 3, 2023 due date) assessed by your filing officers, pursuant to Section 91013.
