No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00383; Doria Robinson for Richmond City Council 2026 and Doria Robinson

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an AdWatch submission indicating that you and your candidate-controlled committee, Doria Robinson for Richmond City Council 2026 (the “Committee”), failed to include the proper advertisement disclosures on the cover or header photo of the Committee’s Facebook page and bio section of the Committee’s Instagram page.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding advertisements. For this reason, we are closing this matter without further action.
