**No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00391; John Craig for PAUSD Board 2026,
John Craig, Linda McGeever (Treasurer)**

Dear John Craig, Linda McGeever, and Committee:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a complaint alleging that you failed to timely file your candidate intention statement (Form 501) prior to soliciting and receiving campaign statements and failed to timely file an amendment to your statement of organization (Form 410) within 10 days after qualifying as a committee.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaigns for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed the missing campaign statement(s). For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file a Form 501 and an amendment to your statement of organization), assessed by your filing officer, Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters, pursuant to Section 91013.
