No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00482; William Valle

Dear William Valle:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the County of San Diego regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) as a Member/Alternate/Advisory Member of the Board of Directors/Policy Advisory/Decision-Making Group for the San Diego Association of Governments (“SANDAG”).

Because the notifications regarding your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency’s email address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you responded and filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the County of San Diego.
