No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2024-00013; David Miller and David Miller for CalPERS Board 2021

Dear David Miller and David Miller for CalPERS Board 2021:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an FPPC Audit that determined you failed to timely file a Pre-Election Campaign Statement covering the period ending September 22, 2021, with CalPERS and failed to timely file multiple 24-Hour Contribution Reports with CalPERS, with all but one timely filed with the Secretary of State.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for State Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed the missing campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file Pre-Election Campaign Statements or 24-Hour Contribution Reports), assessed by your filing officer, pursuant to Section 91013.
