No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2025-01048; Jimmy Figueroa

Dear Jimmy Figueroa:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (the “Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a sworn complaint alleging that you failed to timely disclose economic interests on your Candidate Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) and Assuming Office SEI for your position as a City Councilmember for the City of Oceanside.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding SEIs. In addition, you have amended the applicable SEIs. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement, i.e., failure to timely file your Assuming Office SEI for your position as an Oceanside City Councilmember and your Assuming Office SEI for your position as an Alternate for the North County Transit District Board of Directors, assessed by your filing officers, the City of Oceanside and the Clerk of the Board of the North County Transit District, pursuant to Section 91013.
