No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00315; Annette Heldman

Dear Annette Heldman:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the FPPC’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests SEI as a Member on the Schools Association for Excess Risk Board of Directors. However, the Enforcement Division found that you left that position in April 2025.

Because it did not appear that you received any notifications from the SEI Unit pertaining to your Leaving Office SEI, and the notifications regarding your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency’s address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the SEI Unit.
