**No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2025-00073; Committee to Elect Brandy Clark
Moreno Valley School District Board Member Trustee Area 4 2022, Brandy Clark, and
Ron Hupe**

Dear Respondents:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to an anonymous complaint alleging that you failed to timely file semi-annual campaign statements.

The Enforcement Division found that you successfully completed the Commission’s Political Reform Education Program (PREP) course regarding Campaign for Local Candidates and Candidate-Controlled Committees. In addition, you have filed any missing campaign statements. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.

Moreover, completion of PREP exempts you from paying late filing fees for the violations listed in the PREP Agreement (i.e., failure to timely file semi-annual campaign statements, failure to timely file officeholder campaign statement short forms, and failure to provide a copy of your statement of organization termination form to your local filing officer), assessed by your filing officer, the Riverside County Registrar of Voters, pursuant to Section 91013.
