No Action Closure Letter re FPPC No. 2026-00220; Brandon Schlenker

Dear Brandon Schlenker:

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) received a referral from the FPPC’s Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your 2024 Annual SEI as an Alternate Member of the Board of Directors for the Schools Program Alliance. However, the Enforcement Division found that you left that position in March 2024.

Because it appears that the notifications regarding your Leaving Office SEI were sent to your former agency’s email address after you left office, the Enforcement Division contacted you regarding the requirement to file a Leaving Office SEI. Immediately after you received the notification, you filed your Leaving Office SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action. Although the Enforcement Division is closing this matter without seeking a penalty, you are still required to pay any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer, the FPPC’s SEI Unit.
