Chapter 916 of '76 statutes (SB 231) permits local legislative bodies to submit questions to the voters. The vote is not binding on the legislative body. Is such a question a "measure" once the legislative body puts it on the ballot? Section 82043 mentions "constitutional amendment or other proposition which is submitted to a popular vote at an election by action of the legislative body..." Chapter 916 mentions "propositions and questions." Does "other proposition" include "propositions and questions?"

Chapter 916 amends Election Code §3780 and §5010, and adds §5360.
