Please be advised that the deadline date for the submission of a Conflict of Interest Code of the Ruth Lake Community Services District to the Fair Political Practices Commission is February 10, 1977. The District was inadvertently omitted from the list of agencies with jurisdiction in more than one county supplied to this office by the Office of the Controller from which we comprised our mailing list.

Local government agencies with jurisdiction in more than one county must develop Conflict of Interest Codes pursuant to Government Code Section 87300, et seq. for submission to the Fair Political Practices Commission.

Attached is an information package for the development of your Conflict of Interest Codes pursuant to Government Code Section 87300, et seq.

I am informed by Mr. John L. Loomis, Assistant District Attorney that your's is a very small District which would in all probability designate only the Directors for inclusion within the Code. Under such circumstances, you may wish to seriously consider recommending the adoption of a "Small District Code" as set forth in Section VI.A.3 of the informational materials package.
