Dear Mr. Lemieux:

This letter is to confirm my advice to you by telephone on July 29, 1977, regarding with whom campaign statements of the San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District Directors should be filed.

You stated that Water District is composed of four uncontiguous cities, and that several of the directors are elected from entirely within one city, while others are voted upon in more than one city. You asked whether campaign statements of directors who are elected by the voters of single cities should file with the respective city clerks as Government Code Section 81005(d) would seem to indicate, while the others should file with the Los Angeles Registrar of Voters pursuant to Government Code Section 81005(e). I advised that, in this unusual situation, our office believes that for the convenience of members of the public who may wish to view the statements, the reports of all candidates or officeholders of the district should be filed in one location, Los Angeles Registrar of Voters' office.
