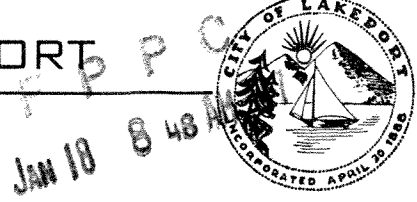

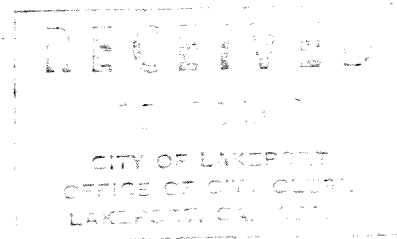

SUBJECT: STATEMENTS OF ECONOMIC INTERESTS



New legislation chaptered in September, 1976 and effective January 1, 1977, requires the Fair Political Practices Commission to establish the deadline for filing Statements of Economic Interests pursuant to Government Code Section 87203. The Commission at its December, 1976 meeting adopted a regulation (2 Cal. Admin. Code Section 18723) specifying April 1 as the filing deadline for the following officeholders:

- Members of County Boards of Supervisors
- District Attorneys
- Chief Administrative Officers of Counties
- Chief Administrative Officers of Cities
- Members of City Councils
- Mayors
- City Managers.

The closing date for the report is December 31, 1976. The report will cover the period from the closing date of the last statement filed pursuant to this chapter through December 31, 1976. The statement may be filed at any time after December 31, 1976 with the city or county clerk (district attorneys file with their agency) but must be filed no later than April 1, 1977. The clerk will forward the statement to the filing officer, the Fair Political Practices Commission within five (5) days after receipt.

The report must include investments, interests in real property and income and gifts held or received at any time during the period covered by the report regardless of whether they are still held at the time of filing.

NOTE: If a person assumes office between October 1 and December 31 and files a Statement of Economic Interests 10 days prior or 30 days after assuming office, that person need not file an additional statement until one year later than the date specified.
